The Paced Bicycle Land speed record, where a cyclist pedals in the draft of a moving vehicle, has stood for 23 years when Denise arrives on the Bonneville Salt Flats. To succeed she will need to pedal the 5-mile course just inches away from an 800-horsepower drag racer. One wrong move could be fatal in the pursuit of the impossible.
